ORDER

HESSE, Chairperson: On August 17, 1990, the San Jose-Evergreen Community College District filed a request to expedite an appeal and filed a contingent request for determination of date of effectiveness of disaffiliation. In the interest of judicial economy and in order to obtain a complete record, the Board requests all parties to brief the issue of whether the Board should determine the effective date of disaffiliation in

this proceeding, and, if so, what the effective date should be.¹
The briefs shall be filed with the Board no later than September
5, 1990. The above-referenced case was previously given expedite
status by the Board.
