DECISION

SHEK, Member: This case comes before the Public Employment Relations Board (PERB or Board) on appeal by the State Bar of California (State Bar) of the January 3, 2007, PERB Appeals Assistant's administrative decision denying, as untimely filed, the State Bar's opposition to Evagelia Lisa Vorgias's (Vorgias) appeal of the dismissal of her unfair practice charge.

The Board has considered and issued the decision regarding Vorgias's appeal of dismissal. (State Bar of California (2007) PERB Decision No. 1904-M.) Therefore, the State Bar's administrative appeal is now moot (Richland Elementary School District (1978) PERB Order No. Ad-36) and is hereby dismissed.

ORDER

The appeal of the administrative decision denying, as untimely filed, the State Bar's opposition to Vorgias's appeal of the dismissal of the unfair practice charge in Case No. SF-CE-389-M is hereby DISMISSED WITHOUT LEAVE TO AMEND.
